Deborah shared current enrollment. In the event Proposition 30 does not pass in November, trigger cuts of \$450 per student will take effect. The State is allowing schools to implement up to 15 furlough days. In preparation schools in Shasta County are currently planning 5 days, RPCS has opted to do the same.
