Speakers must wait outside of the Board Room until they are called upon, with no less than six feet of distance between themselves and others at all times. Face coverings are required inside the Rocky Point Charter School Board Room, except when exempted by state order. Members of the public may remove their face covering while speaking to the Board. There will be no seating available to the public in the Board Room.
