COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY AMENDMENT 2022-23

Masking:

We follow local and State required masking policies. At this time masking is optional.

Hygiene

- Students will be taught and reinforced hand washing, avoiding contact with one's eyes, nose and mouth and how to properly cover coughs and sneezes with the elbow..
- Handwashing will be encouraged throughout the day, especially before and after eating, after recess, after using the bathroom and after handling garbage.

Testing

Testing is no longer a requirement.

Visitors:

We welcome visitors on our campus and ask only that anyone who is sick or has symptoms of infectious illness to please stay home.

Facilities:

- Air filters will be replaced and a greater intake of fresh air will be used in the ventilation system.
- Air purifiers will continue to be used in classrooms and offices
- Water fountains will be flushed to flush out drinking water systems that have been left idle.
- Classrooms will be cleaned once per day and fully disinfected if a space was occupied by a person sick with COVID-19 within the last 24 hours.

In Case of Illness:

- Staff and students who are sick must stay home. Testing and rapid contact tracing will help to prevent the possible spread at schools, and is offered free of charge on-site and take home tests are available.

COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY AMENDMENT 2022-23

- Staff members and students with symptoms of COVID-19 infection may not to return for in-person instruction until they have met CDPH criteria to return to school for those with symptoms:
 - Stay home for at least 5 days with at least 24 hours have passed since resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications; and
 - Other symptoms have improved
 - **OR** a Negative COVID-19 Test or alternate diagnosis may return after 24 hours without a fever without fever reducing medication.

In Case of Positive COVID-19 exposure/test:

We have testing capabilities on campus.

- When a positive case is identified on campus, we will conduct a deep cleaning and watch for symptoms in the student cohort.
- For those who test positive, they must isolate themselves at home for 5 days and move to independent study. They may return to school after 5 days with a negative test or 10 days without testing.
